



Course Title: *1-DAY FOREIGN DISCLOSURE COURSE*

Target Audience: Navy and Marine Corps operational military personnel working with or planning combined or coalition operations or exercises.

Description: This course teaches the workings of the foreign disclosure process from an operational military point of view. It is intended to provide sufficient information so that when disclosure issues and interactions arise, attendees know how to engage disclosure officials and submit approvable packages for foreign release. It provides generic templates, guides, and samples to demonstrate how best to interact with disclosure officials. The ultimate aim of this course is to have attendees learn how to incorporate the disclosure process into operations and exercise planning instead of engaging the disclosure office as the last step before a foreign interaction.

Course Topics Include:

- Terms, definitions, and acronyms used in discussing foreign disclosure.
- National, and Service foreign disclosure policy overview.
- The differences between operational capabilities disclosures and the disclosure of technical data.
- The process of developing and transferring written material to foreign governments.
- Conducting meetings and visits with foreign government representatives.
- Preparing and conducting briefings to foreign government representatives.
- Disclosure issues associated with Foreign Liaison Officers, Personnel Exchange Program representatives, and U.S. military personnel on exchange assignments overseas.
- Operations and exercise planning considerations, and typical disclosure process review timelines.
- Understanding the differences between a Security Classification Guide and Foreign Disclosure Guidance.
- Typical disclosure issues associated with intelligence products.
- Interacting with and preparing packages for submission to the Foreign Disclosure Officer.

Length: 1 days (8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m., 1-hour lunch, 12:30 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. each day)

Delivery: Instructor-led classroom training

Course Prerequisites: None required. However, successful completion of “DoD Foreign Disclosure Orientation” (GS190.06) found online at the Defense Security Service Academy (<https://enrol.dss.mil/index.htm>) may help attendees understand some basic disclosure processes and terminology.
